
Granola Bar Collection Now through September 8

Exciting EPH News

Approximately 2 years ago, our Ecumenical Partnership for Housing (EPH) family successfully completed the EPH transitional program and moved from our Ruth House duplex to an EPH long-term home on North Platten Street. The family has been renting this home since they moved. Many Resurrection parishioners worked at the North Platten home in preparation for the move, made a meal for the family and/or kept the family in prayer.

While living in the North Platten house and participating

in EPH case management, the mother was able to increase her income and credit score thus putting herself in a financial position to get approval for a home loan from three financial organizations! She asked EPH if she could purchase the North Platten home at market value, \$182,000. The EPH board approved the home purchase and will use the home sale proceeds to purchase another home for EPH. This is the second EPH family to purchase a home from EPH.
