“...the stars will be falling from the sky...”

At the end of time and the end of our church year, apocalyptic readings, from Daniel to the book of Revelation, remind us of times of struggle. There are moments in history when life seems overwhelming and unbearable. The situation in Ukraine as well as the situation between the Palestinians and Israel are good examples of these struggles. Maybe a moment of a health diagnosis that feels unbearable.



Often it is not hard to imagine or to be deceived into thinking that the “sky is falling.” These moments are when we lose hope and usually run and hide. A true apocalyptic moment is when life is unbearable and yet we can still hold on to hope and the promise that our God will never leave us alone. God not only does not abandon us but is always triumphant over evil and deception. This is the basis of salvation.

I remember little Daniel, who had leukemia as a child. As he came in with his Dad for chemo treatments he always had a fighting spirit within him. Daniel was mischievous in word and action. He would always say that my head was too big for my body! He never lost hope. When his treatments were no longer effective, Daniel became more ill. I will always remember that between Daniel and his Dad, whether here on earth or in heaven, their faith proclaimed a victory. God’s loving Spirit would always guide them through what would be very difficult days ahead.

Sometimes life seems unbearable and overwhelming. Our scriptures call us to trust in God no matter what happens to us or our world. All “things” can be taken away from us and yet who we are and what we believe is always ours to treasure. This is the gift of our faith. Prayer is the vehicle between ourselves and God’s divine presence that reassures us and redirects us toward our source of life and hope, especially when we think the “sky is falling.”

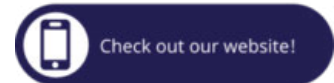

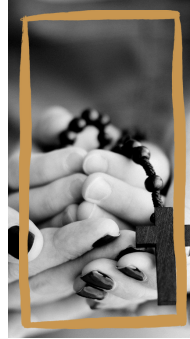
