



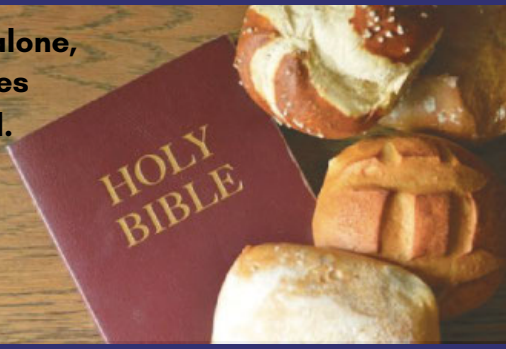

Bread of Life Discourse

Through the month of August, our gospels shift from the Gospel of Mark to the Gospel of John. The main reason for this is that Mark is such a short gospel that there is not enough material to cover all the Sundays of this year. So, from the 17th Sunday to the 21st Sunday of Ordinary Time we dive into the Bread of Life Discourse. It's a great journey of faith in eternal bread from heaven.



Do you “eat to live” or “live to eat”? I tend toward “eat to live” except when celebrating special events and there is a mountain of food. I also “live to eat” when someone else is cooking! Most days I just get by with the basics of nutrition so that I can stay healthy. Yet other times, the banquet of food and drink take on a higher level of meaning and purpose. We celebrate life with birthday cakes; wedding unions with great feasts, drink and dancing. We celebrate faith and family here at Resurrection Parish through a “feeding” that raises us up to a Eucharistic frenzy. Nothing takes us above and beyond ourselves than a meal and a prayer!

We will be bringing forth these life-defining moments of food all throughout August. Through the Gospel readings Jesus gradually reveals His true identity and invites us into a life of union with Him. Last week He fed the multitude. This week Jesus claims those who hunger will hunger no more for He is the Bread of Life. Then Jesus continues to challenge us, stating that if we do not feed on His flesh and blood we will have no life, as He has the words of eternal life.

Of course all of this is centered within the context of our celebration of Eucharist. We come together each week to break bread in community. Our prayers all point us to go in and through that simple bread and wine to taste and see the real presence of God's goodness right there in front of us.

Centering ourselves in God and the One Body and One Blood of Christ, we walk in love as the mystery of Church. Eating and drinking, feeding and quenching thirst, we will serve the Lord!

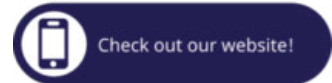
