## This Child is Destined

Mary and Joseph must have been overwhelmed with the birth of their child named Jesus. As they presented Jesus in the temple, they would not have expected Simeon and Anna to proclaim such heavenly hopes and dreams. Jesus was proclaimed to be a path of salvation, a light for revelation, and a glory for God's people. His parents were amazed at what was said.



When you were parents or godparents presenting your child(ren) for baptism, were you amazed and overwhelmed at what was proclaimed about your child? Each child or adult at baptism is held up in prayer with the expectation of salvation, to be a light of revelation and a bearer of truth. That is a high expectation of this sacrament!

As with Jesus, so with each one of us, we are called to be Christ in our world. Through our parents, family, and church community we are to be formed and graced into a life in Christ that is beyond us in God's realm and yet within our ordinary moments of life. Each moment of heaven on earth leads to the next until we are as amazed as Mary and Joseph with our own family and parish life.

With my mother's death and funeral last week, I was amazed with all the many people, including myself, who voiced ways in which my mother touched their lives, bringing them closer to Jesus. # Save Money—and the Planet—with a Sustainable Swap!

How much money do you spend on paper towels every month? How about every year?

In 2017, Americans spent a total of about \$5.7 billion on paper towels, and that number has continued to climb in the years since. But as great the economic cost of paper towels is, the environmental cost is much higher. The production of paper towels contributes to deforestation, wastes water, and creates carbon emissions, and when paper towels break down in a landfill, they emit methane, a huge factor in global warming.

Time to ditch the disposables and switch to reusables! As an alternative to single-use paper towels, try using reusable "unpaper" towels, Swedish dishcloths, and cloth rags for everyday cleanup, and save your paper towels for tasks that could ruin your reusables, like wiping up excess grease, or are unsanitary, like cleaning up pet messes. Forgoing paper towels might mean doing a little extra laundry, but it'll be worth the long-term savings—both for you and the planet!
