## **Finding Abundance in Simplicity**

This Lenten season brings us closer to the "simple" faith and lifestyle Jesus left with us throughout the Gospel of Luke. We will hear of Jesus being tempted by the devil; His presence transfigured in the presence of the disciples; a story of the fig tree that no longer produces fruit; the story of the prodigal son; as well as Jesus' refusal to condemn a woman of good faith. All these lessons point us to simplify our relationship with God, our neighbor, as well as ourselves. This one simple path leads us to Jesus' suffering, death, and resurrection that we will celebrate at Easter. Less is more!

As you plan for Lent this year, what needs to be simplified in your life? It could be decluttering your house or attic. It could mean simply clarifying your relationships with family and friends. It could mean simplifying your prayer life and choosing a prayer form that is most meaningful at this time in your life. It could mean simplifying your diet, your wardrobe, your buying habits, your use of technology, your energy and water consumption, or your internal thoughts that are not helpful for healthy relationships. Simple ashes will lead the way into Lent. Less is more!

In our Gospel today, Luke says, "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit." It is simple and straight forward. It is logical and meaningful. Who we are simply brings us to what we do in life. I pray that Lent will be a time for you in your life, and all of us here at Resurrection Parish, to simplify our lives so that we can simply be as Jesus in our world today. Less is more!

from the Care for Creation Committee Looking for a quick and easy way to lower your energy bills? If you're still using incandescent light bulbs, make the switch to energy-efficient lighting! According to the US Department of Energy, lighting accounts for about 15% of the average household's electricity use. While energy-efficient LED light bulbs cost a little more up front than traditional incandescent bulbs, LEDs use up to 90% less energy and last up to 25 times longer, so the average household can save an estimated \$225 in energy costs per year just by using LEDs! For further savings, consider using timers to turn off lights when they're not in use and dimmers to lower lighting levels.
