Rest assured there is something new that awaits us as we place our hope and trust in God's path of salvation.

Pray that our simple vision of Jesus' mercy will guide us toward a new Easter that is abundantly springing forth in us today.

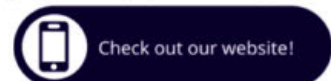
