

Change is always difficult. Learning something new is not easy nor is letting something go. I have reached the point in my life where I REALLY have to want it in order to learn something new. As Ruby always tells me, it's hard to teach an old dog new tricks — just give me the treat!

Isaiah has new tricks for an old tribe of people. Clearly, Israel is on a bad journey outside of God's covenant of love and hope. Once again, God promises to call them back home and will do something new for a faithful Israel.

Isaiah is tweaking our curiosity of what could be just around the corner. Imagine what our world could be like if we claimed God's ways above our ways. A world where mercy was chosen over misery; love and unity over hate and division; diplomacy over war; listening over oppression. God promises us something new that brings new life and hope. So why is it that our world seems to choose the old ways of fear and intimidation to gain power and control for our own gain and wealth? This is an age-old dilemma that answers why we know the Cardinal Sins always lead to our destruction and misery.

Lent is a vision that looks toward the abundance of Easter. The resurrection of Jesus is the intersection between the old road of selfishness and greed and the new road toward peace and justice for all of God's creation. Rest assured there is something new that awaits us as we place our hope and trust in God's path of salvation.

Pray that our simple vision of Jesus' mercy will guide us toward a new Easter that is abundantly springing forth in us today.




