Opening My Eyes

A few weeks ago, I was looking for a replacement ink cartridge. I knew I had one and what the box looked like, but I couldn't find it anywhere I searched. I tore apart every drawer, every cabinet, every possible place I could have stored it to no avail. It was days of periodically scanning my place, hoping it would jump out at me. In that time, I was going without it and getting annoyed (my German stubbornness didn't allow me to purchase another replacement).



Lo and behold last week, I was opening a drawer to grab a roll of tape, and ta-da, there was the ink cartridge, sitting so nicely in the front of the drawer. But it wasn't in the original box like I thought and was looking for. Somewhere along the line, I must have taken it out of the box, leaving it in just the wrapper. My eyes were looking for the wrong thing the whole time.

Has this ever happened to anyone else? You think you know exactly what you're looking for but it turns out you were blind to the truth. That makes me wonder, if my eyes are not open to seeing the simple things right in front of me, what else am I missing?

We all experience blindness, deafness, lameness, and muteness throughout our daily lives. We get so wrapped up in ourselves and pursuing what we believe to be right, while not being open to what Christ calls us to experience. We get distracted in our own wants, that we forget to see, listen, speak, and act in the ways of God. I know there have been plenty of nights when I reflect upon my day that I realize I missed the boat on being open to being Christ to others — "I should've noticed that at the time." "I should have said this." "I should've done that." — but I can't live in should'ves, only in do-better-tomorrow with the grace of God.

Our readings this weekend remind us that Jesus came to open up every aspect of ourselves so that we can fully live in relationship to others and to God. His command of "ephphatha" must be at the forefront of our minds. Maybe this word needs to be written across our bathroom mirrors as we get ready for the day, as a reminder to stay open to God throughout the day.

Over this next year of a stronger focus on prayer by "Praying Always and In All Ways," it is my goal to open my eyes, ears, body, tongue, and more importantly my heart to experiencing the fullness of Christ while fostering a richer relationship with God. Will you join me?

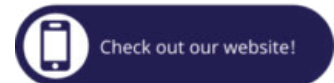

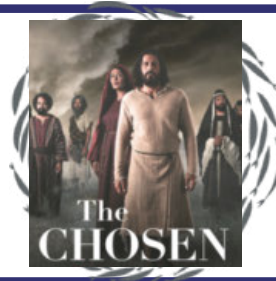

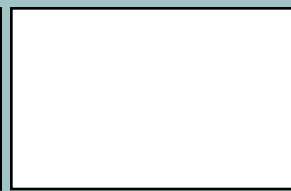
