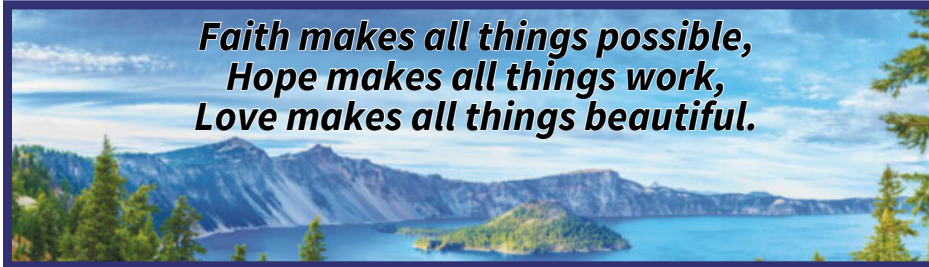

### Prayer = Love

As you read this I will be relaxing and enjoying the beaches of the Pacific Ocean in the state of Oregon. There are many rave reviews of these beaches and rock formations. I am sure I will LOVE every minute of my time in the midst of such beauty and majesty.



When we use the word LOVE, it often gets confused with enjoy or like. I love (enjoy) walking my dog. I love (like) pizza. But when we hear Jesus speak of love it is always in relationship with another. His love for his disciples, for the poor and marginalized, for his Father in heaven, for Lazarus, all point toward something deep and profound.

True prayer always leads to love. True love always brings us to prayer. They are clearly intertwined because in essence they are the same. Prayer opens us to the mystery of life beyond us that then ties us together. That all may be one. That peace may come when there is truth and justice for all involved. Love is that interweaving of our lives that is already present and eternally forming us into the fullness of God's presence.

When Peter acknowledges Jesus as the Christ, he is saying that he experiences Jesus in full relationship with our Creator and there is a full, active Spirit in everything Jesus says and does each moment of life. Prayer and love are this inner presence of life's ever-expanding, ever-bonding action that surrounds us. We are rarely fully conscious of this reality and yet we participate in it each moment of life.

In the Letter of James, we see this connection being made between faith and works. Faith can be seen as prayer and works as the action of love. If either is missing, then the connection and action is empty and meaningless.

We have much to learn and experience about prayer and love over this coming year. I will begin this journey in the grand, majestic nature that will surround me along the Pacific Ocean. Nature always brings connection to my heart and relationships. It is such great prayer!

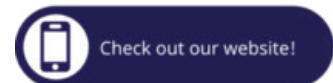

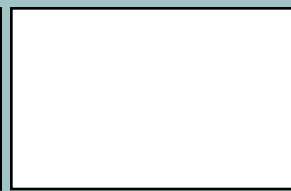
