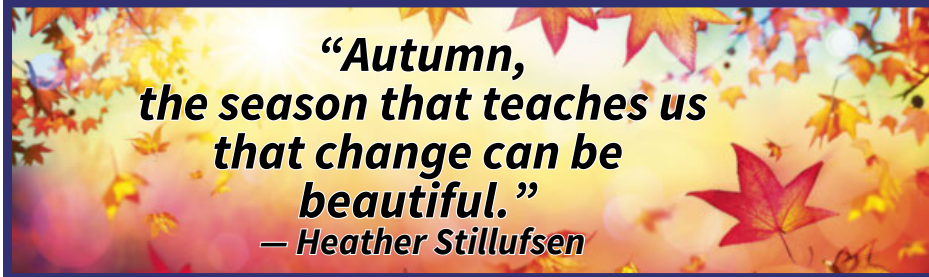

Embracing Fall: A Season of Change and Reflection

In this Sunday's readings we are reminded how we should judge the prophetic voices we hear today. Are they voices leading us to live a Christ-like life? If not, they are not true prophets.

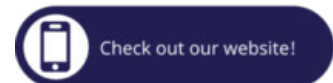

The Rosary is a prayer that always accompanies me; it is also the prayer of the ordinary people and the saints... it is a prayer from my heart."

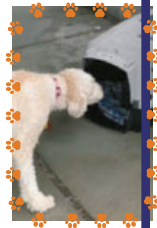
