A Place To Go

The old Pichler homestead southwest of Eau Claire, in Pepin County, was where my dad grew up. Throughout his childhood, the only option for a bathroom on the farm was an old outhouse that sat down the hill and across the barnyard. It wasn't until my dad was married and had kids that my grandparents had indoor plumbing installed in the early '60s. Yet, one bathroom was hardly sufficient for a family of twelve, so the outhouse remain



was hardly sufficient for a family of twelve, so the outhouse remained in use. It wasn't the most convenient place to relieve oneself, especially on a cold, winter day. But we could count on a bathroom, whether indoors or out, whenever it was needed.

Maslov's Hierarchy of Needs has five levels, ranging from the basic needs of life such as food, water, clothing, and shelter on the lowest rung of the ladder, up to the highest level of self-actualization. Since being exposed to Maslov's hierarchy in high school psychology class, I have never thought about the presence of a bathroom, about the ability to take care of nature's calling, as being included on that hierarchy. Until these past few years.

StreetLights Outreach is now 20 years old. That is twenty years of providing a positive presence on the streets and picnics in at-risk neighborhood parks. The one thing that has become more and more evident with that presence is the lack of bathroom facilities in the downtown area, especially in the evening and overnight. Our brothers and sisters who are experiencing homelessness literally have nowhere to go for shelter or to go to the bathroom. As I get older, that has become personally more evident to me, as I need to use the facilities in our nice, warm home prior to going down to the streets and knowing that there will be one available for me when I return. But that is not the case for our brothers and sisters who lack sufficient shelter.

This past week we asked some guys who were staying behind the Micah Center, trying to dodge the impending rain and thunderstorm, whether a porta-potty would be helpful to them. Without even a blink, the guys stated that their bathroom was behind a dumpster and that a place to go with a little more privacy would be welcome. More privacy, more dignity, and improved sanitation were the thoughts that entered quickly into my mind.

While details are still being worked out about a place for a porta-potty, Whatsoever You Do, Inc. intends to provide a facility with people living on the streets serving as monitors to make sure that it remains safe and clean. The cost per month for such a service will be \$250. Would you join me in providing a place of privacy and dignity for our brothers and sisters to take care of one of their most basic human needs? 
