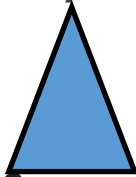
OPEN DISCUSSION/OPEN FORUM (Fr. Tom shared the following)

- 2. Lent involvement has been good. The six of ten saints have been shared there will be an eleventh surprise saint at Easter.**
- 3. Friday; World Futures Day was attended by our staff; Fr. Paul and Sheila DeLuca. Bishop Ricken attended with a group from the Diocese. GRACE also at a group in attendance. Large companies brought groups in as well. The focus was A.I. We will have change in the future; fantasy stuff but it is real. Digital spaces to put information out.
