This week in a very special bulletin article...

I like to think of myself as kind of a classic TV aficionado. I grew up knowing when an announcer said “on this very special episode,” a main character was about to confront a highly emotional issue. An often-used trope in these types of episodes is temporary blindness, such as “Fonzie’s Blindness” in Happy Days. I remember watching this episode as a child and I can still feel the despair and anger of someone losing their sight while their loved ones support and encourage them to move into a new way to live.



But we all know TV is not 100% true to life. Thankfully I have been blessed to experience life beyond a TV show. While Fonzie may have been my introduction to someone experiencing blindness, I have had the privilege of meeting individuals who deal daily with diminishing or complete loss of sight. Dan, Molly, and Tom are three individuals I have met in only the past year who have taught me immensely about true sight and about life.

After a life of academics, Dan’s sight has been reduced to a small shadowy tunnel. Alexa’s voice fills his house as she completes tasks for him and strategically placed stickers guide his fingers to where they need to be. But Dan has no problem finding humor and quirkiness in life. He is finding new ways to navigate through life without losing sight of who he is.

Similarly, Molly’s sight has been gradually slipping away over the past few years. It’s inevitable that darkness will be all she can see. As I’ve witnessed her journey, she has shared her angst of letting go and facing the coming darkness. She may not be able to control her sight but she can control her attitude and acceptance.

In addition to recent homelessness, Tom has experienced blindness his entire life. Despite the hand he has been dealt, he still exudes joy. His smile always lights up the dark night as we share stories and talk about common interests. It is being heard and seen that gives him life.

We all experience blindness in one way or another, sometimes physical and sometimes deeper. Jesus gave Bartimaeus his sight after displaying a faith in which nothing could prevent him from calling out for mercy, even the discouragement of others. Do we allow obstacles to get in our way of seeing Christ in our midst? Do we let negativity hold us down from calling out to God? Does our blindness prevent us from following Jesus? As this very special bulletin article comes to a close, together we call out to the Lord to open our eyes and see the beauty of life.

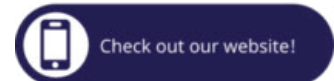

We believe in the communion of saints, which means that the faithful on earth can seek the intercession of saints in heaven. Praying to saints is a way for us to ask for their prayers and support, much like asking a friend to pray for them.

This practice is rooted in the understanding that saints, having led lives of exemplary holiness, are close to God, and can intercede on behalf of those who seek their help. We can pray to saints for specific needs, such as St. Anthony for lost items or St. Jude for desperate situations. 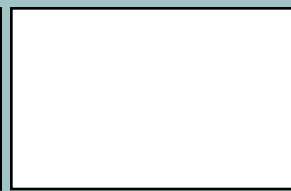
