A Penny For Your Thoughts

I wish everyone at Resurrection Parish could meet my friend Penny. She is a middle-aged woman who lives in an apartment near St. John's Park. Our StreetLights Outreach volunteers met Penny when she walked across the street one night last summer to say hello and grab a bite to eat. Little by little we were able to learn that Penny not only has one of the biggest smiles you will ever encounter, but she is generous beyond belief.

Penny works as a cake decorator at the eastside Dairy Queen on Main Street. I have to admit that I absolutely love DQ frozen cakes with their layers of goodness. Penny was able to share what goes into making those cakes and the secrets of how the deliciousness comes together.

One evening Penny came over to the park again, but this time she was carrying something in her hand. After the usual greetings and hugs, with a check-in on how our day had gone, Penny reached out and gave me a bag, filled with nothing other than pennies. Yes! Penny had given me a bag of pennies (and some nickels, dimes and quarters as well)! For a woman who only works a few hours a day making DQ cakes, this donation of pennies felt greater than the checks that show up in our mailbox, sometimes in the amount of \$50 and sometimes more than a \$1,000, to pay for the outreach activities of Whatsoever You Do, Inc.

In the first reading for this weekend from 1 Kings, the prophet Elijah encounters the widow at Zarephath who only has a handful of flour and a cup of oil to feed she and her son. When Elijah asks her to feed him, the widow admits that her and her son will die soon as their food is running out. Elijah promises that since she was so generous to him, the widow and her son would eat for another year. And they did!

In the Gospel of Mark, Jesus tells the story of the widow who gave two mites, two pennies, to the synagogue treasury. Jesus shares that this woman, who gave all she had in her poverty, provided from a greater depth than those who were wealthy.

In these coming weeks, we have an opportunity to reach into our purses and wallets, our bank accounts and investment dividends to help our parish reach out to the poor in our community. The annual parish stewardship letter, asking you to consider an increase in your generosity to make possible the plethora of programs and offerings that happen here, is coming your way.
