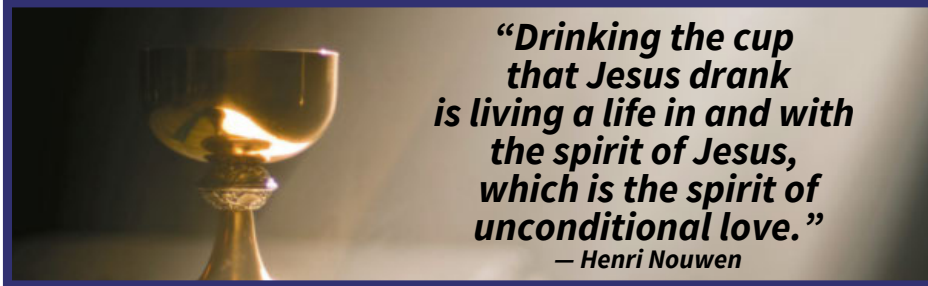

Can You Drink the ‘Suffering’?

I met a gentleman at the homeless shelter last winter who described his life with his mother as they lost their housing with a relative. He was in the men’s shelter and Mom was in the women’s shelter. He had tears describing the challenges of finding work that would support them.

The suffering was present...

I met a woman who was in a marriage that was riddled with alcohol abuse, infidelity, and physical and emotional abuse. She could not find a way out of her misery. Where would she go? It was the life that she had known for so many years that it seemed impossible to imagine anything different.

The suffering was present...

I met a young man who was struggling with his sexuality. He “tried” to be straight but finally had to admit he was gay. Some family and friends accepted him and others rejected him. He had tears describing the drastic changes his life was undertaking at the time.

The suffering was present...

The powerful symbol of the cup Jesus offers to the disciples in the question, “Can you drink the cup that I drink?,” is what we face every day in our lives. We all have difficult situations that ask us to respond in a way that brings us through our suffering into the light of resurrection. As with these previous life situations, there was a choice between staying in the suffering without hope, or finding courage and strength to walk through the pain and suffering to find hope and salvation.

As a parish we have chosen to recognize and act upon the suffering we find in the community around us. Our prayer is to enter into the pain of our neighbor so as to bring hope to those most in need. This is our gift of being resurrection in prayer and in action. Collecting blankets for those who sleep on the streets, food for those who are hungry or visiting the homebound, we drink the cup of salvation and are Christ as we serve in Jesus’ name.

Are you willing to drink of the suffering, to give of your life so that others may simply have a life?

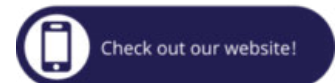

The cries of the poor are a gift to us, to stir God's spirit in our hearts: we are all rich and poor, we are weak and strong, we give from what we need.

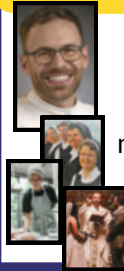
Refrain:

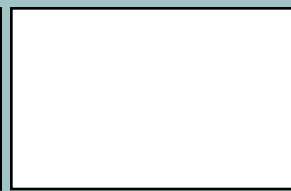
