#### The Tie That Binds

As some of you may know, I am the oldest of 15 children born to my parents between 1949 and 1972. We would sometimes drive to Milwaukee to visit my grandparents, and once in a while as we drove along, we would see another car passing us where someone could be seen counting how many of us were in one car.



We would laugh over this, but we were taught to stick together and to take care of each other. There were many other lessons we learned growing up, but then that is what happens in a family. We all come from some kind of family – a family that, for better or worse, forms us in our early years.

Jesus grew up in a family in the little country town of Nazareth, in the region of Galilee. Like us, he learned many lessons as he grew – from obeying his parents to doing the chores to learning the trade of a carpenter. Yet, as Pope Paul VI reminded us, there is a long silence surrounding Nazareth. We don't know anything of the daily life that formed the young man who was the carpenter's son. What we do know is that his parents, Mary and Joseph, turned out an excellent specimen of the best humanity can offer – our Savior.

On this Holy Family weekend, let's remember and honor where we came from and the people who formed us. Deo Gratias!






