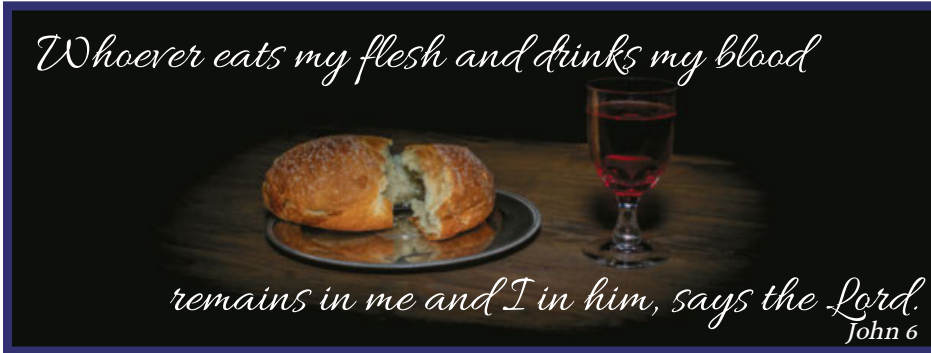

I Am the Living Bread

The sixth chapter of the Gospel of John is probably the topic and time in Jesus' life when most people ran away from this crazy man named Jesus. The Jews at that time quarreled for a reason. John has Jesus saying that "unless you eat the flesh of the son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." WOW! This counters all human sensitivities as well as theological understandings of God. John very much intends to blur the lines between heaven and earth.



If Jesus is the "living bread that came down from heaven," then we can eat of the flesh/bread that is Jesus. The manna God provided is of God, the eternal Jesus is of God, therefore we are thankful for the real eternal presence of God in the Eucharist. It is great comfort and hope in my life to know that we have a loving God and we are God's people. That is heaven and earth united in Jesus.

Dcn. Steve Meyer brings this down to earth for us with his statement in his book, *Living with Real Presence*. "When we think of real presence in Eucharist, we tend to forget that presence is not a thing; it is an experience, an encounter, and a real form of intimacy. If we dare go deep in our spirituality, we discover that real presence is a way of life, perhaps the way of life that brings hope, compassion, peace, harmony, mercy, joy, and love to us, to our relationships, and to all humanity. It is the source of all happiness now and forever." There appears to be nothing more intimate and life changing than an interchange between God's self-giving mercy (manna) and our hunger and thirst for God's real presence. This is always an experience of grace and joy.

Each time we encounter Jesus sacramentally in flesh and blood and are transformed in the ways of Christ we are affirming the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. In this I find great joy for myself and others.

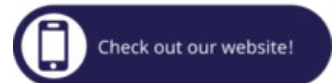
